Uniquely Handcrafted Sterling Silver Jewelry by Scott David Plumlee

Guarantee of Craftsmanship

Thank you and congratulations on successfully obtaining an original Davidchain jewelry design. Individually handcrafted with quality controlled sterling silver round wire and semi-precious gemstones; individually selected for color, clarity and shape. I utilize a variety of simple hand tools and employ a symphony of ambidextrous hand-eye coordination skills to wrap, weave, and assemble jumpings into uniquely didactic jewelry designs. I strive to create heirloom-quality jewelry that balances the physics of comfortable wear and the aesthetics of metal to mineral. Through a persistent desire to find perfection within the happy accident, I have developed over 80 original chain designs, each backed by mathematical formula, quantified to the hundredth of a millimeter.

I stand behind my product with a guarantee of craftsmanship. Due to the cold-working chain making techniques employed, individual rings have the potential to twist open when torqued by enough force, which can theoretically causing the chain to break. If you have an original Davidchain jewelry design that should ever need physical repair, please contact me first and then mail it with a SASE to the address I will provide and I will fix it for free. For a service fee, I can do minor alteration and restoration to a previously created Davidchain jewelry design; such as shorten or lengthen the chain's length, add or remove a centerpiece, change the mineral type of bead embellishment, or the 'bling-bling' cleaning in my steel-shot tumbler. Note that this guarantee I limited to normal wear, if you drop your bracelet into the garbage disposal, don't expect me to perform a miracle, but I will give you a discount on a new piece.

Each Davidchain bracelet or necklace is chronologically saluted with a three-digit index number stamped onto the index ring connecting the clasp to the chain design. Each signature s-clasp has been hand-forged with a hammer against an anvil from round wire. Utilizing simple blacksmithing techniques this design is extremely strong, easy to utilize, and has no moving parts to break. To aid arthritic hands, I have also designed a magnetic clasping system. Upon request, a magnetic clasp can be substituted for the s-clasp on any of my chain designs.

Sterling silver is an alloy composed of 92.5% silver and 7.5% copper; this small amount of Cu allows the wire to be stronger and malleable by hammer and anvil. However, this added Cu reacts to humidity, resulting in the chemical process of oxidation, which tarnishes or darkens the metal to a soft gray hue. If the wearer's pH balance is overly acidic, the chain can become very dark from continuous wear. The oxidation/ tarnish is only on the surface of the metal and can be cleaned by scrubbing with baking soda or by utilizing any after-market silver cleaners to remove the oxidation.
