I utilize three 'common knowledge' chain designs, as follows. The Byzantine, aka the King's Braid, Idiot's Delight and Birdcage. The second is the Inca Puño, which I first saw in Peru, aka Box and Queen's Braid. The third is the Micro-Diamond, which I started making in 2001, but is independently known as the Romanov.

Other than these three exceptions, all other chain designs have been created with old-fashioned trial and error with didactic leaps of intuition. I have taken a singular jewelry course at the Appalachian Center of Crafts in 1995, since I have worked in an artistic vacuum, barely keeping up with my mathematically inspired creativity.
